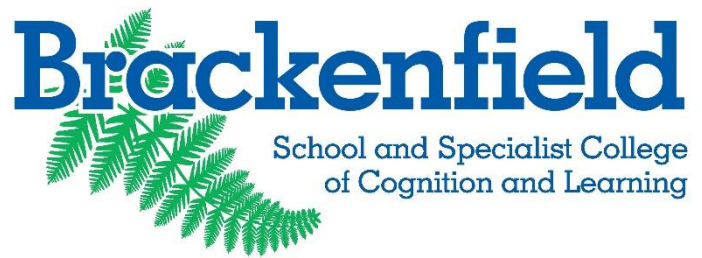


Literacy and Numeracy Catch Up Premium Summer 2016- Spring 2017



“Where everyone has a voice”



Our 2016 and 2017 literacy and numeracy premium allocation was £4500.

This grant is available to be spent for the educational benefit of pupils registered at our school.

During this academic year we invested in the creation of a bespoke intervention programme, meeting the needs of our pupils who are required to make rapid progress in literacy in order to access the wider curriculum. (£2500)

This programme is delivered by a LiAC (life skills across the curriculum) Lead Teaching Assistant. This programme currently supports 8 pupils within our secondary population. Slots are timetabled to avoid core subjects and support cross curricular application of literacy and numeracy.

Through the intervention we are also purchasing non-fiction life learning books to support literacy and numeracy across the curriculum. (£500)

Our new sensory themed library has received additional resources, selected to be accessible to our pupils during their 'reading for pleasure' library slots. Each half term classes will complete a story telling related activity, to share with the whole school. (£500)

Our numeracy intervention requires additional resources. This will be delivered within lessons and on a 121 basis. This will be supported by baseline numeracy assessments (awaiting delivery within school). (£450)

We have allocated reading schemes for each pastoral base ensuring accessible reading material supporting recorded progress in reading. (£1000)

For Summer 2017-Spring 2018 we will invest in numeracy intervention resources and practical numeracy resources for cross curricular embedding. This will be audited before purchase, in line with our school curriculum, specifically life skills. Next year's allocated amount will be £8500.

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
