Rationale

Speech and language support is required to help pupils understand and express themselves throughout school. Many of our pupils have speech and language needs identified in their statements. The addition of a Speech and Language therapist means that we meet these requirements and are also able to support teachers to make classroom environments conducive to pupils needs.

The reading scheme supports a greater emphasis on the importance of reading and literacy across the curriculum and supports pupils with independent learning goals.

The Maths scheme supports learners across the whole school.

Additional support staff are in place to give pupils who require it additional support to reach targets and learning objectives.

Measuring the impact of PPG spending

Progress of pupils has been monitored termly at Pupil Progress Meetings and the level and nature of support has been adapted accordingly.

Progress has been monitored during lesson observations and evaluation of progression data and in work sampling

Impact of Speech and Language support has been monitored across the curriculum and particularly in the Speaking and Listening strand of English.

Individual pupils progress have also be monitored, recorded and fed back to staff via Melanie Saunders (SALT)
